12th RSFI National Sub Junior Rope Skipping Championship - 2011

A GENERAL INFORMATION

1. NAME OF THE CHAMPIONSHIP

The championship is called **The 12th RSFI NATIONAL SUB JUNIOR ROPE SKIPPING CHAMPIONSHIP – 2011.**

2. RSFI (Rules & Regulations).

- a) **Technical Organizing Committee** is responsible to verify the ages of the competitors. Therefore, participating states are requested to submit information in the Forms attached correctly and intact and submit before due date.

3. Transportation:

- a. Arrival: 30th September 2011 from Bhimavaram Station to Accommodation.
- b. Departure: After 4.00 p.m. 3rd October 2011, From Accommodation Place to Bhimavaram Railway Station.
- c. Accommodation: 2.00 Noon 30th September 2011 to 4.00 Noon 3rd October 2011.

4. Food:

1st October BF, Lunch, Dinner

3rd October BF & Lunch,

5. JUDGES

- a. All **JUDGES** must be in possession of a Valid I-Cards and successfully completed National Judges Certification.
- b. Each participating team is requested to provide Judges as per requirement (minimum 1judge).
- c. The Technical Organizing Committee will decide and confirm the designated Judges upon the fulfillment of the judges Technical workshop which will be conducted before the championships.
- d. Judges are required to equip themselves for judging and to submit appropriate Forms before the stipulated closing date.
- e. All the selected judges will be presented a nice souvenir for appreciation.

6. Participation Fee (non refundable)

- a. Registration: Rs. 600/- per person
- b. Participation Fee:
OFFICIAL TEAM Rs. 60/- per event/per person
OPEN CATEGORY Rs. 150/- for first event and Rs 60/- for second event per person

Skippers can avail 25% discount on Registration fee only (not on event fee) by submitting their forms with participation fee before September 15th 2011, But After 15th September, 2011, a penalty of Rs. 1000/-per person will be charged as late fee.

- b. The RSFI Technical Organizing Committee is responsible and reserves the rights to make Final decisions and will assess on the framework of controls including any violations incurred therein both during and after the championships.
- c. All hand outs and information released prior to this Rules & Regulations via e-mail, postal mail are canceled. The latest copy of the Tournaments Rules released by the RSFI will be the Fair copy.

1.1 OFFICIAL EVENTS and OPEN EVENTS

In Open category only Speed 30 sec. & SR Speed Relay events will be held and any state can send as many entries as they want.

OPEN events (Speed 30s & SR Speed Relay) are open to all and any individual may send their entries directly to RSFI office

1.5 NATIONAL CUP- TEAM DEMO (Male and female mix, only one team per state, it should be less than 14 yrs.)

- a) Age : No Age Limit
- b) Gender : This is an Open Event
- c) No. of Competitors: Minimum 4 competitors and maximum of 12 competitors
- d) Routine : 5 to 8 minutes presentation
- e) Floor Area : 12 m X 12 m
- f) Entries : ONE team per state is allowed
- g) Routine : The routine should include all skills as specified below.
- h) Elements: Each element can be performed with any number of people with any length of rope; (Single Rope, Chinese Wheels, Traveler, Long Rope, Double Dutch)

2. CLOSING DATE & REGISTRATION FEES

- a) Please submit the necessary documents to the **Secretariat** via e-mail **AND** postal mail **BOTH**. Earlier registration and settlement of payment will enlighten the processing of accommodation etc. Please adhere strictly to the closing dates for submission Entry Forms along with Entry Fee as follows:-

- **Submission of Forms by September 15th 2011.**
- **Settlement of All payments by September 15th 2011.**
- Notification of Substitution or replacement of competitors by September 20th, 2011.

4. **FORMS**

3.1 Please fill in all the necessary forms as attached genuinely and vet through before sending it by e-mail **AND** postal mail to the above e-mail address before **September, 15th 2011** together with **valid identification documents** for the purpose of age verifications.

5. **SUBSTITUTION**

- a) The Technical Organising Committee will **ONLY** accept entries filled in the relevant Registration Forms. Any Substitution of competitors are not allowed. In the event of unforeseen circumstances, illnesses or injuries prior notice together with a certified medical certificate should be produced and submitted to the Technical Organising Committee.

6. **WALK OVER**

- a) In the event if representatives of any state is absent for the Judges , Coaches and Team Managers Meeting, and if there are any major changes in the Championships (as the case may be) , the Technical Organising Committee understands that the Absentees are aware and knew ALL information to their utmost knowledge.
- b) In the event the competitor fails to appear on the competition floor within 1 minute after being called , it will be considered a ” **WALK OVER** ” and that particular state team will be deleted from the Championship List .

7. **COMPETITION FLOOR**

- a) Championships will be held on quality wooden sprung floor if available.
- b) For Freestyle Events floor measurement will be 12 m X 12 m. (9x9mtrs D Dutch)
- c) For Speed Events floor measurement will be 4 m X 4 m.

8. **GENERAL DIRECTION (RESTRICTED ZONE)**

- a) The competition area is only accessible for the competing competitors.
- b) Other non-competing team , coaches and team managers are strictly forbidden from entering this area until and unless prior consent had been granted by the Technical Organising Committee
- c) All Coaches will be seated at the waiting area. Non-compliance to the above will further cause Warnings .

9. **MUSIC - RECORDING AND DUBBING**

- a) Combination of various songs are allowed . If the music used as an impression of Creativity, it should be performed with attitude.
- b) The routine must fit.sets of Cassettes or Compact Disc must be submitted to the Technical Organising Committee.
- c) Songs should be recorded on "Side A" and MUST be the 1st song .
- d) Playing of many songs for 1 routine from different cassettes and compact disc are prohibited. Songs must be recorded on 1 cassette tape or 1 compact disc only.
- e) If the routine does not fit the music the team will be penalised with a deduction of points for creativity.

10.FACILITIES

The Technical Organising Committee will provide CD Players on the Competition day. Competitors are not allowed to play their own CD players during competition.

11.QUALITY

The Technical Organising Committee will not be responsible of any low quality or due to bad recording of songs. Therefor, please ensure the songs are recorded to good quality.

12 DELAY

- a) The competitors, coaches and or team managers are requested to report to the Head Technical Organising Committee 30 minutes before the championship Starts.The Championship will take place as per scheduled time.
- b) Competitors are requested to be on the competition area 15 minutes before the championship starts.

13. ATTIRES & PROPS

Each State must decide on their team attires.

For National Team uniforms may have their team name, sponsor or logos displayed.

During the championships supportive , appropriate and decent attires should be worn at all times by the competitors.

Hair should be well groomed and long hair to be tied up neatly.

Supportive athletic non-stick sole sports shoes and socks must be worn to protect the skippers feet and competition floor.

No items of jewellery may be worn, except small stud type pierced earrings.

No props or special equipment may be used to add to the creativity or the degree of difficulty of the routine.

14. ROPES

Each routine can be performed with any type, length, weight of ropes The Technical Organising Committee will not provide any ropes during the championships .

15. TIME VIOLATION

Please refer to time provisions for each championship events. Failing to adhere to the time provisions, a penalty of an appropriate minor miss will be applied.

16. APPEALS

The Appeal of any fault by team managers, coaches or other concerns will be entertained on spot only.

17. PROTESTS

In case of protest have to deposit Rs.1000.00 as protest fees and the Technical Organising Committee decision will be final

18. SPECIAL CONDITIONS

The above Rules & Regulations are subject to change as and when the Technical Organising Committee deem fit OR in the event during the Judges , Coaches and Technical Organising Committee, the Rules and Regulations are being revised and the RSFI Technical Committee has every rights to decide and confirm.

All Official papers should be officially signed by authorised signatory/ries Unauthorised official papers will not be identified in the event of any disagreement.
